

## **SEAHORSE – CONTENT INFORMATION**

**Discussion of death and terminal illness** - The play is based on two characters with a condition whereby emotional pain causes literal cardiovascular damage. The narrative revolves around the deterioration of their physical and emotional health. Ultimately there is an implied death.

**Discussion of sexual assault** - While sexual violence never occurs in the play there is a scene in which Harp and Seb discuss consent within their relationship. (Harp having sex with Seb when she isn't in the mood).

**Animal cruelty** - During a visit to a petting zoo, Seb and Harp witness a child kill a rabbit.

**Breakdown of relationships** - The play takes an unflinching look at the 'death' of a relationship.
