

CONTENT INFORMATION - SHEWOLVES

Neglect - The play features a 14-year-old who is often left home alone whilst her Mum goes abroad for work.

Abuse - Priya is 14 and has run away from home. Half way through the play we discover that this is because her Mum's new boyfriend 'Racist Mike' has moved in. Mike has previously been threatening towards Priya and she doesn't feel safe around him. There is an implication that he might hurt her physically. There is a description of him verbally abusing her including a suggestion of using a racist slur against her.

Weaponry - The play includes a character brandishing a taser gun. The gun is also fired - there are no loud sounds as this is demonstrated using music. The gun is aimed towards the ceiling during this moment.

Anxiety - Lou is 14 and she is anxious - we see her struggling with this when she has a panic attack in the third scene of the play. She is supported by Priya.

School exclusion - In the third scene, Lou is excluded from school.
